This year we will be awarding grants of \$500 to \$2000 to each of four or more "not for profit" organizations that are involved in community action in the Greater Cincinnati area. Each request requires a Unitarian-Universalist sponsor--someone who is active in the greater Cincinnati U-U community. Ideally, the sponsor will have first hand knowledge of the project or organization. If necessary, we will identify a sponsor for an applicant. Please note that there can be NO direct benefit of a grant to a member of St. John's. All previous recipients are eligible.

GUIDELINES

- A. Identify the organization – Name, Address, and Phone.
- B. Identify the contact person - Name, Title, Address, Phone, E-mail address
- C. Identify the U-U sponsor - Name, Address, Phone and Church.
- D. Write a brief paragraph describing your organization.
- E. Describe a **specific** project for the funds, and how volunteer hours by our church members might be used by your organization
- F. Specify how much funding is being requested, as well as the minimum amount that would be helpful.
- G. Application and supporting information may not total more than four pages.
